<p>3D is a Crime Concern project aimed at supporting women who live chaotic lifestyles in Southampton. 3D was set up in response to recognition that enforcement alone was not putting women off working the streets. Paid staff and volunteers work with the women in a variety of ways, including: Drugs counselling and support, Education and learning programmes, Guidance which includes one-to-one action planning sessions, Activities to build: self-esteem, art, craft, music and beauty therapy, computing. Advice on Housing, benefits and legal matters. Personal Hygiene care.</p> <p>3D has a strong belief that all sorts of crime issues can be tackled much more effectively if enforcement agencies work together with education and support agencies. Clients have often said that swimming or some other activity with a 3D worker is the only "normal" thing they do. It helps them to get back in touch with a life that is not focussed entirely on drugs or alcohol and the street. The project has been running for over 4 years now and already have seen several women leave prostitution completely and a much greater number substantially reduce their drug and alcohol use and their street sex work.</p> <p>Due to the success of the project there are a growing number of women, who although are not directly involved with prostitution, have links to it or are at risk of entering it, accessing the service. These women are vulnerable and have varying issues including substance misuse, domestic violence, childhood abuse, mental health issues, and homelessness. These are very much the same as the issues which the street working girls experience; these women often have no where else to turn.</p>
